QUOTE OF THE DAYCatherine of Siena, theologian, died 1380

Catherine of Siena was a member of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans) and among Roman Catholics she was the first woman to receive the title Doctor of the Church. She was a contemplative and is known for her mystical visions of Jesus. This gift of mysticism apparently extended back into her childhood, much to the dismay of her parents, who wanted her to be like other children. Catherine was a humanitarian who worked to alleviate the suffering of the poor and imprisoned. She was also a renewer of church and society and advised both popes.

Please continue to pray about who our next Synod bishop will be.




Did you know...


