Bishop William J. Gohl Jr.
Delaware Maryland Synod

The Rev. William (Bill) Gohl Jr. was elected to be bishop of the Delaware-Maryland Synod, ELCA at the 2016 Synod Assembly. At the time of his election, Bishop Gohl was Lead Pastor of Epiphany Lutheran Church and Intern Supervisor/Vice Pastor of St. Luke's Lutheran Church, both in Baltimore.

Previously, he served at Peace Lutheran Church in Glen Burnie and vice pastorates at Our Saviour, Lansdowne; Zion, City Hall Plaza; Faith, North Avenue and assisted at All Saints, Loch Raven and Peoples Community, Baltimore.

More recently, Bishop Gohl provided the Luther's Small Catechism moments during our Synod Assembly in May.
