To the Watersmeet Township Supervisor and Trustees:

I attended the public hearing held by the Planning commission on Sept. 10, 2014.. Two petitions were presented requesting that changes to the building requirements on L1, L2 and RF not be approved by the board. The petitions have a total of 43 signatures. There were approximately 40 people in attendance, 8 of whom spoke against the reduction and 1 person who spoke in favor of the reduction. If a vote had been taken of the public opinion, it would have reflected a resounding no to the amendment.

The past township board worked very hard to mend relations between the "Townies and lakies" only to have a blatant action taken against the wishes of the people done by the Planning commission whose self interests overrode the wishes of the majority. We live in a democratic society. I hope you as elected officials of the democratic process will listen to the majority, not the few self serving people who have completely ignored the wishes of the people.
