Adopt a Bay Cliff door to open new passageways to independence

What is Bay Cliff's goal with doors?

Accessibility is critically important to Bay Cliff's mission. The next step is to install automatic doors on buildings that campers frequent through the summer camp season, including the beloved and historic dining hall, the Big House.

How can you help?

We rely on the generosity of people like you and the organizations you are a part of. You can "adopt" a new door at Bay Cliff, and in turn have a plate inscribed with a message to the hundreds who travel through it every summer.



Here's the plan. We're looking at replacing the aging exterior doors on all key buildings, and adding at least one automatic door to each building. The cost to sponsor a new single exterior door is \$1400. The cost to convert an existing door to an automatic door with a mechanical operator and 2 push buttons is \$1500. A brand new door with the automatic opener package costs \$2900. Through your generosity, our campers both young and old can realize greater independence as they learn to navigate the world. When you sponsor a door, a message goes onto an affixed brass plate, bringing joy, encouragement, or peace to those who pass through.
