

CALL FOR QUALIFIED APPLICANTS FOR THE 2019 ELECTIONS

THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE OF DISTRICT 10 IS SEEKING QUALIFIED APPLICANTS FOR THE 2019 ELECTIONS.

GENERAL PROCEDURE FOR DISTRICT OFFICES

Any qualified member of a club in the district seeking election shall file his/her written intent to the Nominating Committee before **March 22, 2019**. Written intent must include accomplishment of all qualifications set in the current International Constitution and Bylaws. A written letter of support from the member' club must be provided. The written letter of intent, service resume, and club support letter are reviewed by the nominating committee and all qualified candidates must be presented for election. If there are no qualified candidates, then and only then, would nominations for each position be accepted from the floor.

***All positions must be made available to potential candidates in the district**

****Candidates serving in first or second vice-governor positions qualifying them for the next elected post must address in their letter of Intent how their current position has prepared them to advance forward. Current resumes must be attached. Club support letters are not required for seated candidates seeking the next elected position (i.e. second to first vice-governor).**

**DISTRICT TRUSTEE TO THE LIONS OF MICHIGAN SERVICE
FOUNDATION**

GENERAL PROCEDURE FOR TRUSTEE ELECTION

Following the Constitution and Bylaws of the Lions of Michigan Service Foundation, (Article IV, Section 3), candidates must be an active member of a Lions Club in good standing in his/her district and have served as President or Secretary of a Lions club for a full term or major portion thereof, or as a member of the board of directors of a lion's club for no less than three years. *

A written letter of intent, evidence of qualifications, and a letter of support from the member's club must be submitted to the nomination committee prior to March 22.. If no qualified candidates, nominations may be accepted from the floor.

*Trustees may not serve more than 3 consecutive 2-year terms
