GRANT REQUESTS HAVE BEEN SENT TO: SACKERSON FOUNDATION (\$2,000 GRANT REC'D); COMMUNITY FOUNDATION (\$500 GRANT REC'D); FIRST BANK (\$250 GRANT REC'D); ROTARY OF ESCANABA (REC'D \$5,000 WITH POSSIBLE MATCHING GRANT); KIWANIS OF ESCANABA (REC'D \$1,500 TO BE APPLIED TO AN INCLUSIVE SWING); BARK RIVER LIONS (REC'D \$5,000 AND HELP WITH REMOVAL OF EXSITING EQUIPMENT); HEART OF THE NORTH LIONS (REC'D \$13,800); EDWARD JONES-SHERYL RAINS (REC'D \$2,000) AND MANY OTHER FUNDS. FROM HOLY NAME SCHOOL, I HAVE RECEIVED A PIECE OF EQUIPMENT THEY HAVE REPLACED. BARK RIVER HARRIS SCHOOL IS ALSO WILLING TO DONATE A PIECE OF EQUIPMENT. 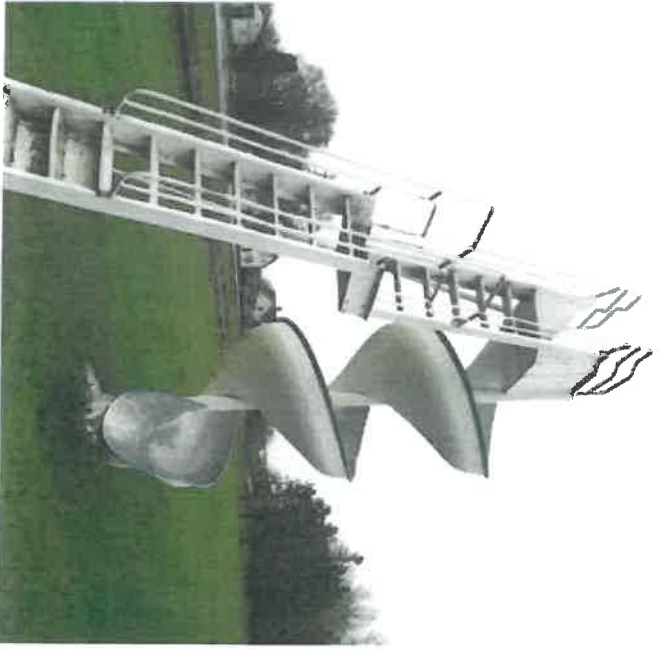
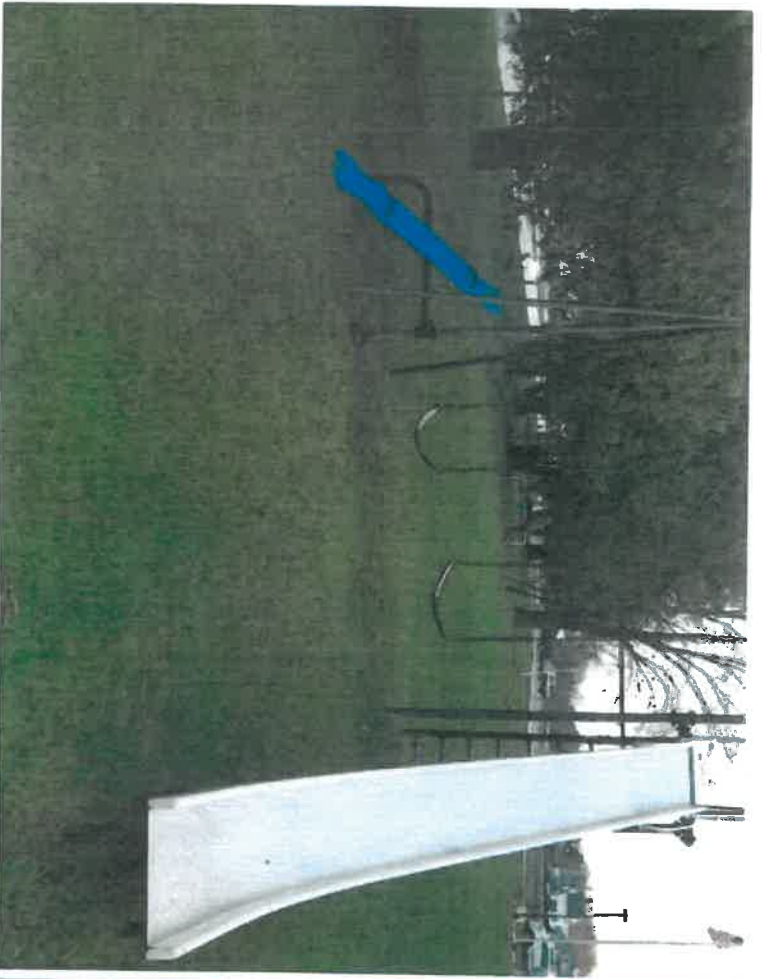

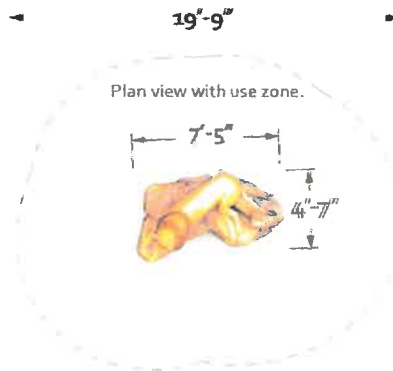
