The M&M Area Community Foundation is looking for volunteers to help with planting the community rain gardens located at M&M Plaza. Construction has recently been completed on the large-scale project and

planting is scheduled for August 12th. **Community members interested must call the Foundation office at 906-864-3599 to sign up.** The goal of the rain gardens is to enhance the quality of stormwater runoff from the M&M Plaza parking lot. Treatment of this direct runoff from the parking lot will have a direct and measurable improvement to the water quality of the river and Lake Michigan. The gardens will prevent 1,830 pounds of sediment per year from entering the Menominee River!

If you are ready to commit 15 minutes a day to personal prayer and 1 hour a week to a group to grow in depth in your relationship with God, this class is for you!

The Prayer Class is being offered this fall at 5 different times:

Monday mornings at 10:30 AM

Monday evenings at 6:00 PM at Bethel

Tuesday afternoons at 1:30 PM

Wednesday evenings at 6:00 PM

VIRTUAL: on Zoom on Wednesdays at 7:30 PM

They all begin the week after Labor Day and go until the first week in December.

Each class meeting will last for One Hour.

Class size: minimum of 6; max of 12 for each time slot

We will learn methods that will expand our definition of prayer.

We will grow in faith through a steady practice.

We will find support in our brothers and sisters in Christ.

The commitment to the group is to meet weekly for 11 sessions between September and December, excepting when you're on vacation or ill, and to pray regularly on your own, using the methods taught in the class.

Everyone is welcome to sign up for any time slot, at either church or online.
