#### FROM THE PRESIDENT

Researchers at Emory University did MRIs on some grandmothers as they were shown pictures of their grandchildren, grown children, and an anonymous child. When the grandchild was smiling the grandmother felt the child's joy; when the grandchild was crying the grandmother felt the child's pain. Now that I am a grandfather, I am not surprised at this result at all. In fact, I am tempted to say 'Duh'. Then the author of this short summary compared its results to the prophet Zephaniah's words about God looking at His people. "He will take great delight in you; in his love he will . . . rejoice over you with singing". And like an empathic grandmother God feels our pain. It is so nice to know that God has real feelings for us. He is not a faraway God, but One who loves and delights in us. Can you imagine Him singing over you?

And this illustrates just how important it is that we all work together in our church. Each of us sees and thinks about things that others may not be thinking about or noticing.
