The Juntos (pronounced “Who-n-toes”) program unites community partners to provide students and their parents with knowledge, skills, and resources to make higher education a family goal.

Research shows that Latino youth are at greatest risk for dropping out of school between the 9th and 10th grades. The Juntos Program reduces this risk by empowering Latino youth by helping them build a peer and adult support network as they transition into high school.
