## The Universal Priesthood: Unfulfilled Promise of the Reformation

Dr. Nesson will focus on the vocation of the baptized as servants of Jesus Christ in daily life.

- ◆ How do we equip the baptized to speak and live the faith in all arenas of life?
- ◆ How do we form and send our members to be the body of Christ in their families, workplace, and local and global community as the primary expression of the congregation's mission?

Dr. Craig Nesson is William D. Strenge Professor for the Education and Renewal of the Church, Academic Dean, and Professor of Contextual Theology and Ethics at Wartburg Theological Seminary in Dubuque, Iowa. He teaches courses in the areas of contextual theology, pastoral theology and theological ethics.

Dr. Nesson has served 11 years as a parish pastor. He holds degrees from Michigan State University, Wartburg Theological Seminary and the University of Munich. His theological interests include ecclesiology, theological ethics, liberation theology, and family systems theory. He is the author of many articles, reviews and books, including *The Integrity of the Body of Christ: Boundary Keeping as Shared Responsibility* (with Arden Mahlberg); *Beyond Maintenance to Mission: A Theology of the Congregation*; and *Shalom Church: The Body of Christ as Ministering Community*.

Dr. Nesson and his wife Cathy have six adult children and seven grandchildren.
