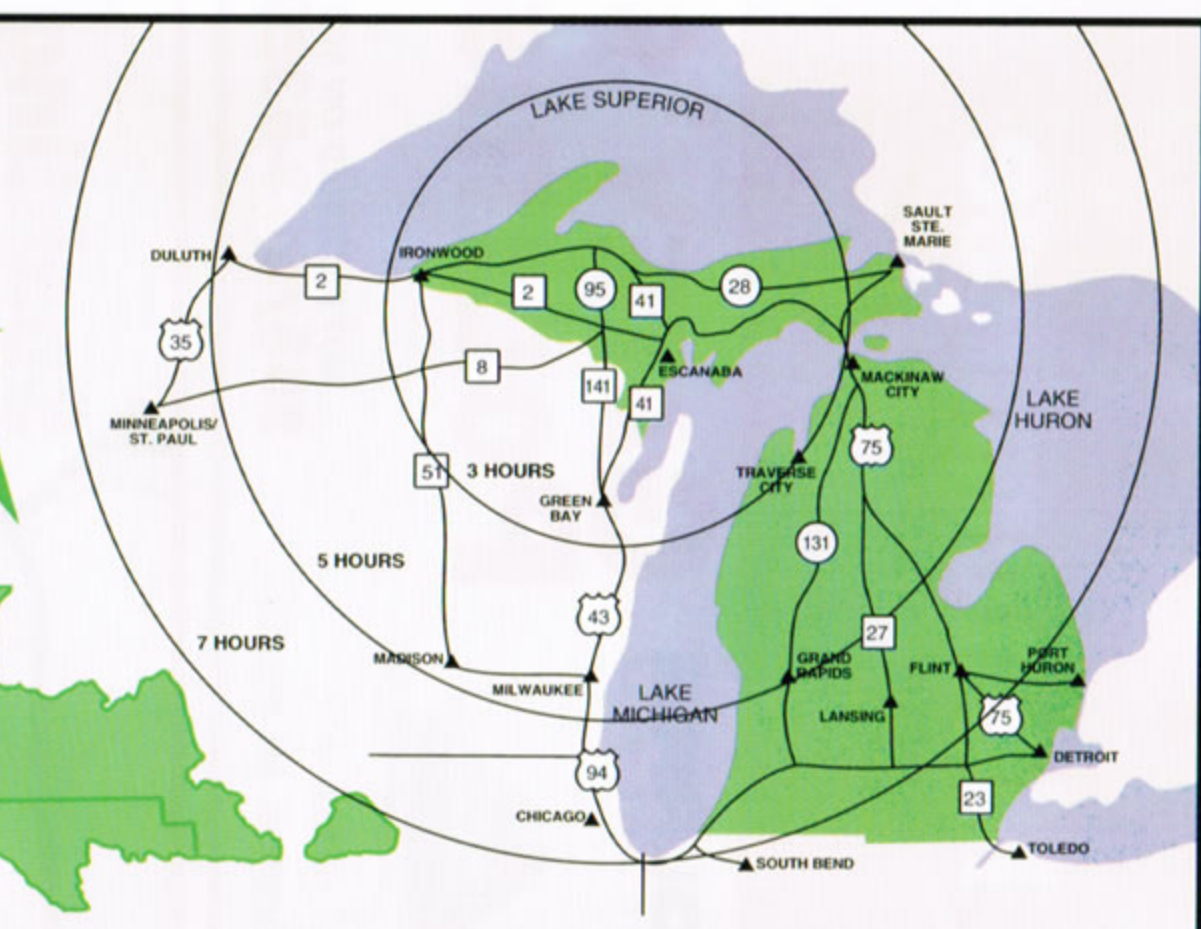

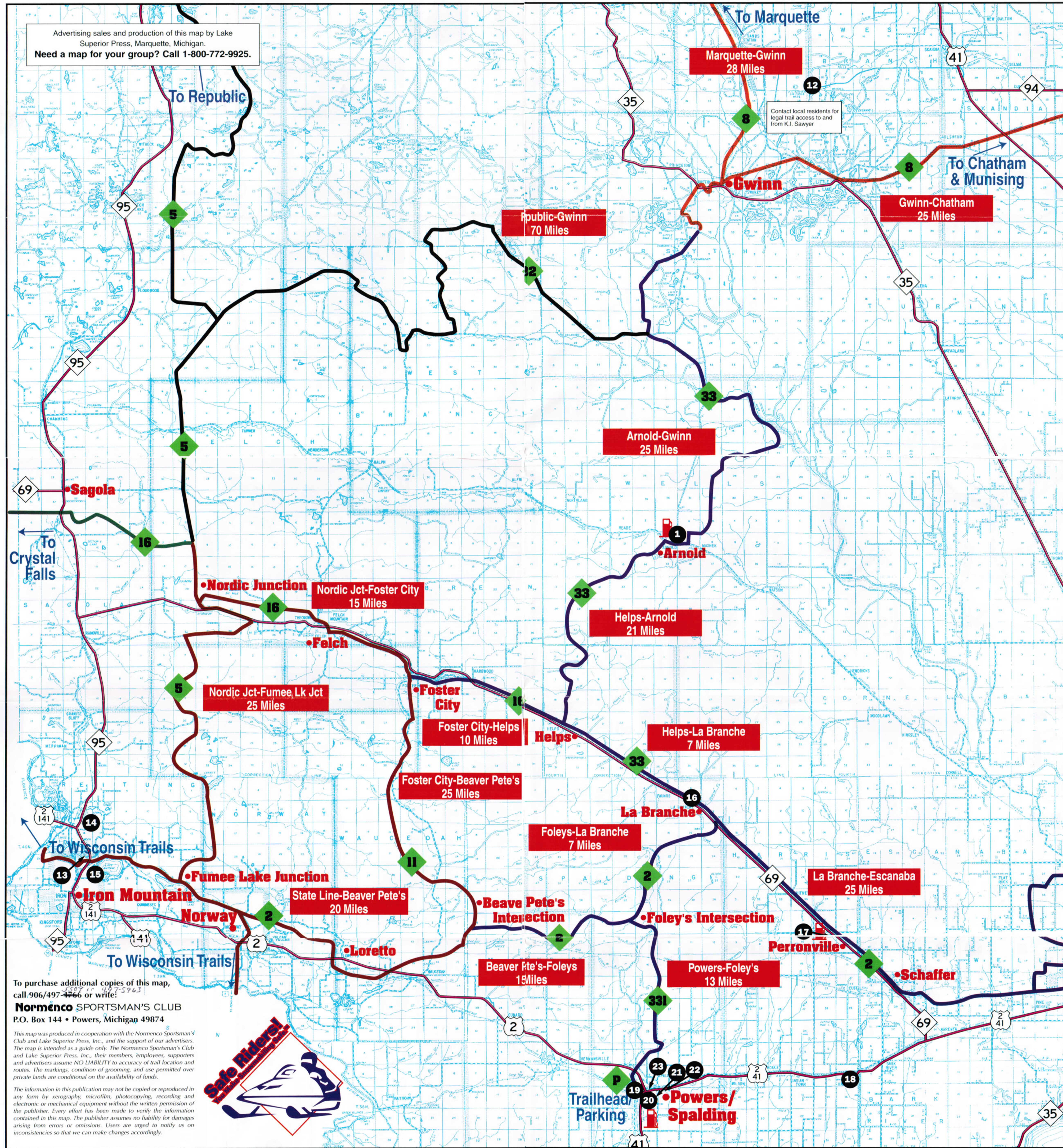

TRAIL PERMITS REQUIRED: In order to continue to provide the best snowmobiling experience possible, the State of Michigan requires all trail riders to purchase and display a Michigan Snowmobile Trail Permit. The funds from these purchases go directly into the trail improvement fund, for the development and upkeep of snowmobile trails. The \$10 permit is available at the State of Michigan License Bureau offices and businesses throughout the central Upper Peninsula issuing hunting and fishing licenses.
