Christmas (Dec 25). If any of the first three (1, 2, 3) falls on Saturday or Monday in a year, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation for that year. Still we will have a Mass on that day too at one of our Parishes. During Lent on Fridays the Stations of the Cross will be at 2:20 PM at St. Joseph Parish and at 5:30 PM at St. Andrew Parish. First Thursday of the Month is Adoration, Confession & Benediction at St. Andrew Parish & First Friday of the month is Adoration, Confession & Benediction at St. Joseph Parish.
