TCHA Meeting

Meeting called to order. Minutes were read; treasurer's report given – both accepted.

Additional nominations for officers:

Point Secretary – Julia Lepinski

Nominations were closed. Invitation for the banquet and ballots will be mailed out.

Year end point book is up to date and will be posted on the website.

Email received asking to have a tack sale in conjunction with the banquet – decided not to have this. Suggestion that they could have it at the fairgrounds in the horticulture building – they would need to contact the fairboard for this and pay any fees. It was mentioned maybe having a spring tack sale – mention this at the banquet.

Discussion on jumping classes – possible elimination of two classes, leaving the Hunter Hack class. Have a rule to be a minimum of two horse/rider entries for the class to be held. Bring this up in February.

Discussion on the speed barns – they are in poor shape and have received complaints that they don't want to rent those stalls. Suggestion to maybe have TCHA make a donation to go towards fixing the speed barn stalls and/or the portable stalls.

Discussion about members - there is a rule about missing three meetings. Should be noted that these members need to be at the shows as much as possible.

Question about reserving judges and to get approvals and show dates and times – reminder that the Fairboard doesn't approve the show dates until their March meeting.

Discussion on show times and days – possibility of changing speed and pleasure days, changing the times, etc. Note this on banquet reservation form and bring up at the banquet. Will be discussed at the February meeting. Reminder - need to be a member to vote. Memberships are due in February.

Deb Strauss is working on year end awards and has most of them ordered.

Reminder on Walkie Talkies – don't throw away the batteries as they are rechargeable.
