## TCHA Meeting

Meeting called to order. Minutes of last meeting were read.  
Treasurer's report given. Motion made and passed to accept reports.

Note – there are some outstanding checks that have not been cashed.

Discussion on jumping classes. Motion from last meeting was discussed – eliminating two jumping classes and keeping Open Hunter Hack. If class is cancelled, cash refund would be given. Motion to eliminate class 54 and 55 – Hunter over Fences and Equitation over Fences, keep Class 56 Open Hunter Hack – with a requirement of a minimum of two entries for the class to be held. If class is cancelled, exhibitor would receive a refund of the entry fee. Exhibitors to sign up for class by Class 44 English Equitation 30 & over. Motion seconded and passed.

Question came up about the break time before Western – with the elimination of the jumping classes, recommended to extend break time to 20 minutes. Motion made and passed to extend break time to 20 minutes before the Western classes.

Tack sale – no interest

Show schedule was discussed. Decided to keep the show schedule the same starting at 9:00 AM.

Year end awards – motion on the floor to change amount for grand to \$35 and reserve to \$30 – no second was made on the motion at last meeting. Motion was seconded – vote was taken – For – 1; Against – 11. Motion failed.

New motion made to change amount for Grand to \$30 and Reserve to \$25 – motion was seconded.

Vote – For – 9; Against – 1 – Motion passed.

Walk-Trot discussion. Liz presented a revised walk-trot class schedule for discussion eliminating some of the Walk Trot classes. The age groups would be eliminated. Discussion on the Open Walk-Trot English and Western classes non-restricted – changes, eliminate, etc. Table until April meeting for further discussion and vote.

Deb Strauss's father passed away. Motion made and passed to have TCHA send flowers with an amount of \$50.00.

Reminder that we will need a list of tractor drivers to turn into the fairboard.

Discussion on judge– complaints on how long the Heather Janssen Memorial Show went on for and time on classes. Judge needs to be more timely – suggestion to obtain a different judge for the show. Or if given another chance, needs to be discussed with judge to have show completed by 5:30pm or close to it or judge will not be approved.

Bits-n-Bridle – judge – Richelle Beene – other judge pending

Judges approved.
