## ABOUT THE AGRICULTURAL MUSEUM

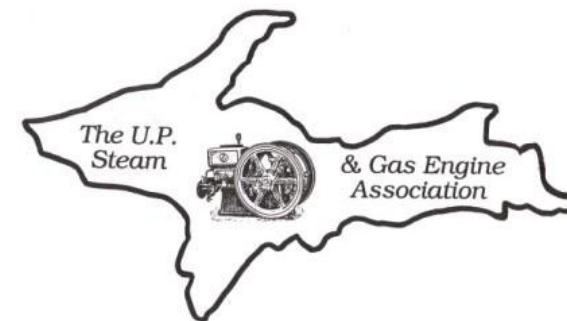

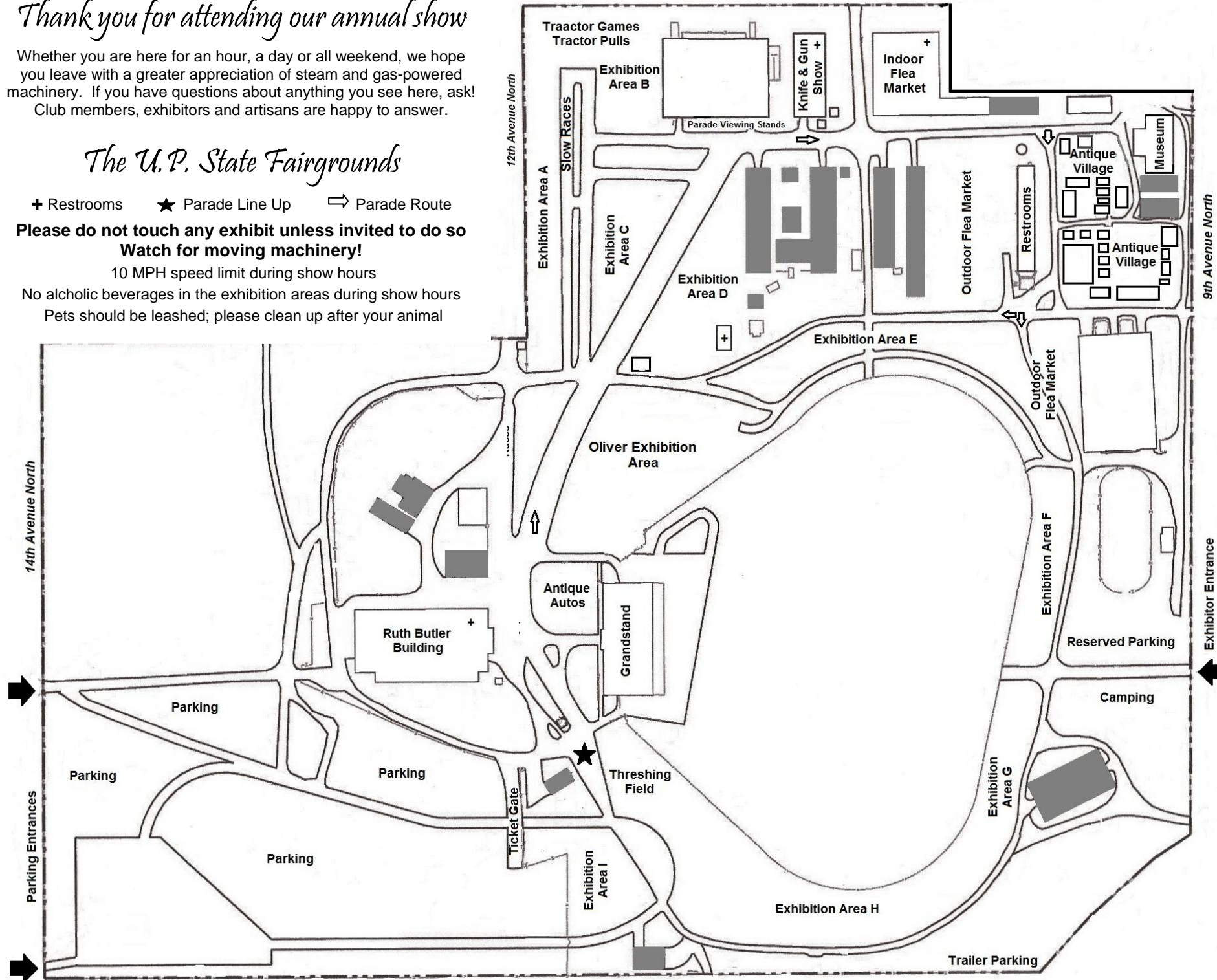
