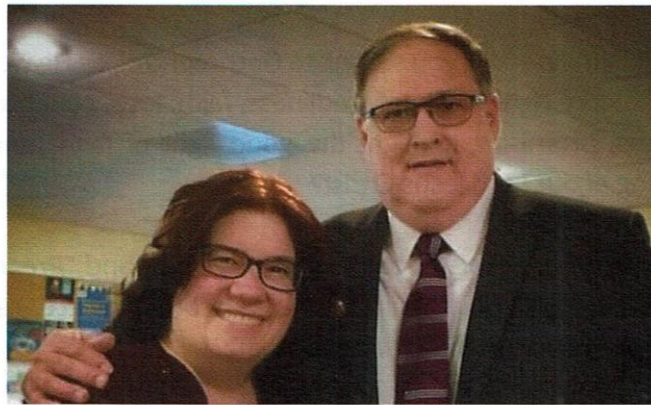

Business Meeting Highlights

1 Gym Project – Due to fire code at the State level the divider wall must be constructed before the final inspection can be given. Motion was made and carried to accept a bid from Roy Ness to construct the wall and install doors for \$29,900. This did not include drywall, finishing and paint.

2 Remodel of Rent “C” house – Motion was made and carried to accept a bid from Shaun DeGrave to do home repairs, doors, windows, siding, soffit, fascia and drip edge for \$24,800.

3 Rent “A” house – Motion was made and carried to accept a bid from Berger & King of \$2,224 for an air purifier and a bid of \$3,970 for Air conditioning unit.
