<u>Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 14!</u> During the season of Lent, we are going to be focusing on Peter's story of discipleship to help guide us on our own faith journey. In Peter, we see a person who is both steadfast and unsteady, a dear friend and a betrayer, a follower and a wanderer. In Peter, we often see ourselves. By following Peter's journey, we watch the story of Jesus unfold through the eyes of a very normal human trying to figure it all out—just like us.

There will be many opportunities to dive deep into your faith questions and be connected to others as we wander alongside Peter together this Lenten season!

- · Wednesday nights come for dinner @ 5:45pm and worship @ 6:15pm with weekly personal faith stories shared, reflection time and prayerful play & singing led by our Logos youth! (Feb. 21, 28, March 6, 13, 20). Ash Wednesday meal also at 5:45 and worship at 6:15.
- · Pick up a <u>devotional booklet</u> that has a weekly reading, song, and journaling practice that connects to the theme for you to use at home as a personal reflection time or for your family or a group of friends to use together!

Lent is a time for all ages to be renewed in our faith journey. May your Wandering Heart experience rest in God's grace and streams of mercy, never ceasing!



Our Lenten journey begins with Ash Wednesday, which falls on Valentine's Day this year. This overlap is a great reminder to us! Church Council

Church Council Meeting Minutes for Thursday, January 11th 2024

The meeting was called to order at 6:07pm by President Lynn Rochon. Present were Lynn Rochon, Pastor Sarah Gunderson, Christel Lewis, Aine Merrill, Margaret Sundet, Sara Schubert McKone, Grace Becken and Donna Meltz.

Devotions were given by Grace. Next month will be Donna.

A motion was made by Sara and seconded by Grace to accept last month's secretary's report. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report: We discussed an example Aine made up to show financial numbers to the congregation to publish in the monthly newsletter. Another example was discussed and Aine and Pastor Sarah will work together on the layout. We reviewed the bank statement and the 2023 income. The checking balance is \$11,765.70, savings balance is \$22,299.07, Thrivent balance is \$3,214.74 and the mortgage is \$41,586.63.

Pastors Report: The next meeting of the Superior ELCA churches collaboration is February 6th. They are working on a shared worship service on Sunday, February 25th at 10am at Concordia. The worship band Breaking Chains will be leading worship and a potluck lunch will follow. We have been challenged to a Souper Bowl competition on February 11th to collect food/ funds to help out our local community. More detail to come. Pastor hopes to begin a grief support group here at Zion in the next couple of months. She will be taking a training course on facilitating grief support from Essentia in Duluth February 8th and 9th. Pastor attended a meeting in December on Parish Nursing ministry. There is grant money and support available through Essentia in Superior for parish nursing ministries. Lent season begins on February 14th with Ash Wednesday. The theme will be Wandering Heart. Pastor would like to include weekly faith story sharing by members of the congregation at the Wednesday services. She is hoping to begin a book study or other 5 week study focus as a Lenten discipleship practice. The ELCA Youth Gathering group will be holding fundraising dinner/concert on Friday, February 16th that Vicky Holm is organizing. Pastor will be in New Orleans on January 18th – 22nd for continuing education and preparation for the ELCA Youth Gathering. She will be in Chetek on Tuesday, January 30th for the NWSWI Winter Theological Retreat.

Discipleship: Sunday School had 2 weeks off over the holidays but is back running now. Teachers are lined up through mid February. Adult Bible Study is Wednesday's at 1:30. **Worship and Music**: Lent is coming up and planning is underway. The altar guild will be working on keeping the left side of the altar area filled.

Operations: did not meet

Stewardship: They are meeting 1 hour before the council meetings. They discussed streamlining member communication, among other things.

WELCA: The cookie sale raised \$731.30. The balance of their checking account is \$1,650.95. A motion was made by Grace and seconded by Donna to accept all reports as given. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business: We need to give a 30 day notice to the congregation of changes to the constitution that the synod wants us to make. We will have to have a special congregational meeting for this and cannot do it at the Annual meeting as there is not enough time to give notice. We went over the 2024 budget expenses. Lynn will send out the income budget for the council to review before it is submitted for the annual meeting.

New Business: A couple reports have come in for the annual meeting report. The current nominating committee is made up of Polly and Lynn. Lynn is not actually eligible to be on the committee so she will contact Anthony, who is not at tonight's meeting, to see if he will be on the committee. We discussed who is on the other committees and which committees will need new members. We discussed having a monthly theme for the food shelf. Sara will work with Paul Robinson about how to announce the theme to the congregation. At the annual meeting, we need to let members know when they give a donation to the 'Food Shelf, they need to specify if they are referring to our food shelf or the food shelf at Faith Methodist Church.

A motion was made at 7:21pm by Donna and seconded by Grace to adjourn. Motion carried.




