

# Alleluia! Christ is Risen! Alleluia!



"And God raised the Lord and will also raise us up by his power." (1 Corinthians 6:14)



Happy Easter! Jesus Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! The season of Easter invites us into living the resurrected life even now. We are God's Easter People! We live knowing the good news that Jesus died so that all might follow him and live. He shows us the way. We are called to be people who act with love and service to others. Jesus told his disciples at the Last Supper, that they were to wash one another's feet, and they were to remember him and eat together, and that people would know they were his disciples by how they showed love for one another.

That is what we do as God's people. We act boldly with love for others, especially those that are facing injustice or marginalization in our world. We show up where and when we are needed with love and grace. We act with the love of Christ and humbly serve all our neighbors. Thank you for all the ways that you do that everyday in our community. You are doing good and faithful work as we care for and feed those around us.

I wanted to share one way the love of Christ is being shared through the ministry partnership we have with our sister ELCA churches in Superior, and invite you into learning more as you are interested. Over the last year, the churches have been working to support Amena, a refugee from Afghanistan, to bring her family to the Duluth/Superior community. A little of her story was told at our shared worship services this past summer and in February, as well as an offering taken in support of this joint work. So her story may be a little familiar to you!

Here's a little of Amena's story: in August 2021, she had to flee Afghanistan when the Taliban took over power there. Amena had been working with the United States military operations there at the time, and her job put her in imminent danger when the Taliban took control. Amena was helped by the US government to flee her home country and arrived in Duluth in January 2022, and she has been working to bring her mom and 2 siblings to live safely here as well ever since. The churches met with Amena and Sister Gretchen Johnston (our amazing music leader here at Zion, who introduced us to Amena) to learn more about how we could help. Sister Gretchen shared with us about the Welcome Corps program.

The Welcome Corps is a new government program began in 2023 as a way for private citizen groups in the United States to sponsor refugees coming from places like Afghanistan. As a part of the program, we are forming a team of at least 5 people who will work together to plan for how the refugee family will find housing, transportation, medical care, and language classes in our community. This team with the support of the 4 churches will also commit to welcome and guide the family in their first 90 days in our community along with fundraising \$2425 per person to help support them during that transition time. It has been a wonderful experience getting to know Amena, and learning how we as the Superior churches working together can support her in bringing her family to the United States.

You are invited to an informational meeting on <u>Tuesday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6pm at Pilgrim Lutheran Church</u> to learn more about the Welcome Corps program and how you can help support this important work. ## Church Council

Church Council Meeting Minutes for Thursday, March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024

The meeting was called to order by President Lynn Rochon at 6:02pm. Present were Christel Lewis, Aine Merrill, Margaret Sundet, Pastor Sarah Gunderson, Sara Schubert McKone, Shannon Johnson and Lynn Rochon.

Devotions were given by Aine Merrill. Next month will be Lynn Rochon. A motion was made by Christel and seconded by Sara to accept last month's secretary's report. Motion carried.

**Treasurers Report**: The checking balance is \$9,062.54, the savings balance is \$15,000.00 and the mortgage is at \$40,244.61. Greg Kvam couldn't be at tonight's meeting. He will be here next month to review and discuss eliminating dedicated fund categories on the financial reports.

**Pastors Report**: We are wrapping up the Lenten journey in Sunday worship, Tuesday small groups (in-person and Zoom) and Wednesday bible study. We have had art projects and faith stories on Wednesday evenings along with worship led by our Logos group. Holy Week will include Maundy Thursday worship with First Communion, Good Friday with Prayer stations and Saturday Easter Vigil service with s'mores. Easter Sunday worship is at 9am and 10:45am at Zion, Sunrise Ecumenical Service at 6:45am at Wisconsin Point Lot #1. Logos Youth Easter Breakfast is at 8:30 – 10:30am. Our Superior ELCA churches are working to support a young woman from Afghanistan named Amena, who is hoping to bring her family here to the Duluth/Superior area. Amena arrived in Duluth in January 2022 after fleeing her home when the Taliban took over power in Afghanistan. She had been working for the US military at the time, and so it was not safe for her to stay. Through the Welcome Corps program, the churches are working to form a team that can help bring her mother and 2 siblings to live with her here. An interest meeting will be held at Pilgrim Lutheran on Tuesday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6pm for anyone who wants to learn more about this project and how you can help. We have taken offerings at our last two shared worship services and will be working jointly to fundraise about \$5,000 more in the next few months to support this effort. Bishop Laurie will visit the LOGOS youth on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, Holy Humor is Sunday, April 7<sup>th</sup> and The Youth LOGOS Retreat will be Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup>, details still being worked out for that.

**Discipleship**: Sunday School's last day will be May 19 with a graduate recognition Sunday and LOGOS last day will be May 8<sup>th</sup>. Eater breakfast is being served by the LOGOS for a fundraiser for their group.

**Worship and Music**: They are thinking about how they can use the PVC pipe/supports on the back of the altar. We will be going to one Sunday service starting on Memorial weekend, Sunday May 26<sup>th</sup>.

**Stewardship**: They are brainstorming spring and fall drives, like PBS does spring and fall membership drives. They are planning on having outdoor activities on June 19<sup>th</sup>. The same company that makes the waving arm man on Tower Ave also makes a Jesus waving man. They are discussing if we should get that and put it out, just once in a while. They are also discussing creating a gathering space where the playground equipment used to be.

**WELCA**: A lunch is planned in May at Perkins for the women of Zion. On Thursday, April 11<sup>th</sup> they will be cleaning the kitchen.

A motion was made by Christel and seconded by Margaret to accept all reports as given. Motion carried.

**Unfinished Business**: A special congregational meeting will be on Sunday, April 21<sup>st</sup> to accept the changes to the constitution. It will be announced at the services on April 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>.

Paul is still determining if mailboxes will be reassigned. We will discuss New Year Visioning at the next council meeting.

**New Business**: We will discuss the financial reports at the next council meeting when Greg is here. The sub pump project was completed late this afternoon. The sewer project is also complete. We wrote thank you notes to all the Lutheran churches in Superior for supporting our food shelf, to our City Council representative the City Plumbing Inspector and Dan Ingersoll for the Ping Pong table he donated.

A motion was made at 7:24pm by Christel and seconded by Shannon to adjourn. Motion carried.
